### WINEMAKING NOTES

The Russian River Valley Pinot Noir is always a fan favorite. When you look at the three single-vineyard Pinot Noirs we produce, they all bring something different to the table. The Bucher brings lush fruits and lots of earthy notes. The Starscape Vineyard brings the very easy drinking qualities of red fruits and soft tannins. Hallberg brings structure to the wine as well as darker fruits and Asian spices. When we create a barrel selection from these vineyards the result is a complete wine with several layers and flavor profiles. This is our best representation of the Russian River Valley.

### TASTING NOTES

Bright ruby in color with a floral perfume giving way to blackberry, raspberry and cherry cola. The first sip announces intense, bold dark plum and baked spices while the long finish eludes to green tobacco leaf.
