WINEMAKING NOTES

The Van der Kamp vineyard is on the eastern side of Sonoma Mountain overlooking the town of Glen Ellen and is a coveted source of Pinot Noir for many of the top producers in our area. Our fruit for this wines comes from three different sections, resulting in equal parts of Mt Eden, Dijon 777, and a section of vines planted in the '50s. To make this wine even more special, it is the only vintage Van der Kamp will be a single-vineyard designate for Joseph Jewell. I had a unique opportunity in 2021 to work with this fruit and jumped on it—you'll see why when you taste it!

TASTING NOTES

Flavors of bright and tart red fruit with tangy cherries first leaping from the glass, followed by notes of strawberry and rhubarb. Subtle hints of resinous herbs add complexity, while delicate violet notes provide a touch of floral sophistication.
